Shonali Pachauri is an energy and environmental economist. She is the Deputy Program Leader of the Population and Climate Change (PCC) Program at IIASA since 2008. She also works one-third of her time with the Global Energy Assessment (GEA) in the Energy Program as of 2008. She joined IIASA as a Research Scholar in the Population and Climate Change Program in October 2005.

Dr. Shonali Pachauri received her Ph.D. from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology Zurich (ETHZ) in 2002, following which she worked as a Post Doc with the Centre for Energy Policy and Economics at ETHZ. She also holds a Master's degree in Environmental and Resource Economics from University College London.

Her research interests include the analysis of the socio-economics of energy access, use and choice; resource use and access in relationship to lifestyles, poverty and development; energy demand and fuel choice modeling; and the analysis of embodied energy of household consumption in developing countries.
